

Privacy Policy

Farm and Fish for Life (“we,” “us,” or “our”) is committed to protecting the privacy of everyone who visits our website, contacts us, or supports our mission. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect through farmandfishforlife.com (the “Site”), how we use and protect it, and the choices you have. By using the Site, you agree to the practices described here.

We serve individuals with mental health challenges and diverse abilities, and we understand that many people who reach out to us are sharing information at a sensitive and personal moment. We treat every inquiry with care, discretion, and respect.

1. Information We Collect

We collect information in two ways: information you provide directly, and information collected automatically when you use the Site.

Information you give us directly. When you fill out our contact form, request support, refer someone, or make a donation, we may collect:

- your first and last name
- your email address
- the subject and content of the message you send us
- your phone number, if you choose to provide it
- any additional information you voluntarily include in your message, which may include details about your circumstances or the person you are referring

Donation information. If you make a donation, payment details such as your card number are collected and processed by our third-party payment processor, not by us. We may receive confirmation of the donation and limited details such as your name, email, and the amount given.

Information collected automatically. Like most websites, our Site automatically collects certain technical information through cookies and similar technologies, including your IP address, browser type, device information, pages viewed, and the dates and times of your visits.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

- respond to your inquiries and provide the support or information you request
- process and acknowledge donations
- communicate with you about our programs, services, and events, where appropriate
- operate, maintain, and improve the Site and our programs
- keep records and comply with our legal and administrative obligations

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties.

3. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

Our Site uses cookies and similar technologies to help the Site function properly, remember your preferences, improve performance, and understand how visitors use the Site. You can control or disable cookies through your browser settings, though some features of the Site may not work as intended if you do.

4. How We Share Your Information

We share personal information only in limited circumstances, including:

- **We work with trusted third parties who help us operate the Site and our organization — such as our website host, form and email service providers, and payment processor. These providers may access personal information only to perform services on our behalf.**Service providers.
- **We may disclose information when required by law, subpoena, or other legal process, or when necessary to protect the rights, safety, or property of our organization, our participants, or others.**Legal requirements.
- **We may share information in other ways if you direct or authorize us to do so.**With your consent.

5. Sensitive and Health-Related Information

Because of the nature of our programs, you may choose to share information about your health, mental health, or personal circumstances when you contact us. Please share only what you are comfortable sharing through the Site. Any such information you provide is used solely to respond to you and to determine how we may be able to help. We are not a medical provider, and information submitted through this Site is not a substitute for professional medical or mental health care. If you are experiencing a crisis, please contact a qualified professional or emergency services in your area.

6. Data Retention

We retain personal information for as long as needed to fulfill the purposes described in this Policy, to maintain appropriate records, and to comply with our legal obligations. When information is no longer needed, we take reasonable steps to delete or securely dispose of it.

7. Data Security

We take reasonable administrative, technical, and physical measures to protect the personal information we collect against loss, misuse, and unauthorized access. However, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

8. Your Privacy Choices and Rights

You may contact us at any time to ask what personal information we hold about you, to request corrections, or to request that we delete information we are not required to keep. You may also ask us to stop sending you communications. Depending on where you live, you may have additional rights under applicable privacy laws; we will honor those rights as required by law. To make a request, use the contact details at the end of this Policy.

9. Children's Privacy

Our Site is not directed to children under the age of 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. Where our programs involve minors, we work directly with parents, guardians, or referring caregivers. If you believe a child has provided us information through the Site, please contact us so we can remove it.

Our Site may contain links to third-party websites, including our donation platform. We are not responsible for the privacy practices or content of those sites, and we encourage you to review their privacy policies before providing any information.
